You find a \$100 bill on the ground while walking home.

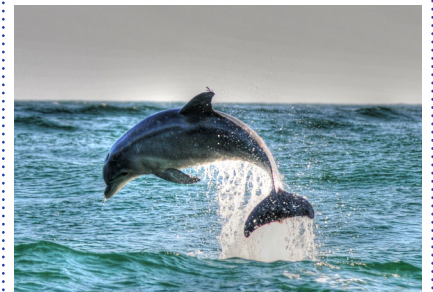
You get a high score on your favourite video game!

How to Use These Cards:

- 1. Print and cut out** the scenario cards. Place them at the centre so students can pick one.
- 2.** Students will read their chosen scenario and write 2-3 exclamatory sentences reacting to it.

How to Use These Expanded Illustration Cards:

1. **Print and cut out** these illustration cards.
2. Students will choose an illustration and write 2-3 exclamatory sentences based on the emotion the image evokes.
 - Example (Anger): A child angrily stomping away from a broken toy:
 - “Oh no! My favourite toy is broken!”
 - “I can’t believe it’s ruined!”
 - Example (Fear): A child stuck in a tree:
 - “Help! I’m going to fall!”
 - “I’m so scared”
