Colours	red, blue, green, yellow, purple, pink, orange, black, white, brown, gray
Sizes	tall, short, big, small, tiny, huge, large, little
Emotions	happy, sad, nervous, excited, calm, cheerful, scared, angry, tired, proud
Textures	soft, rough, smooth, bumpy, shiny, fuzzy
Weather	sunny, rainy, windy, cloudy, stormy, cold, hot
Shapes	round, square, oval, triangular
Personality Traits	brave, curious, kind, helpful, thoughtful, playful, adventurous
